



Presented by the McCall Behavioral Health Network OPR stands for Question, Persuade, and Refer - three simple steps anyone can learn to help save a life from suicide. As a QPR-trained Gatekeeper, you'll learn to recognize the warning signs of suicide, how to offer hope, and how to refer someone to resources in the community to help save a life. QPR is a nationally recognized, evidence-based training that grants participants certification considered active for three years.

Registration Deadline is December 15th


