### **Region #6**

The Work Group for Increased Collaboration with Litchfield had a meeting a week ago Monday and worked closer to getting a draft proposal document prepared to circulate to the four Communities: Warren, Morris, Goshen and Litchfield. The region realignment would allow each town to maintain their current elementary schools as is, as many of us know, anything to the contrary would most likely be an immediate deal breaker. The Middle School would likely be housed at a Litchfield site, and the High School along with the Ag – Tech Program would at the current Wamogo campus. After nearly 70 years, our communities will be given the opportunity to discuss the proposals and vote at the November 2, election. Stayed tuned, much more to follow!

**Housing Plan Meeting June 3.** The group is encouraging anyone interested in Community Housing to observe the meeting this Thursday and become more active at our next Community Housing Forum.

There will also be an article in our next town newsletter which will be out shortly. We already have some out in the community, and there is one to see at the Town Hall if you are interested.
