The Town Meeting was called to order by First Selectman Gregory LaCava at 7:31 pm.

The First Selectman asked the Town Clerk to read the call. The call was read by the Town Clerk.

First Selectman LaCava asked for nominations for Moderator. Colleen Frisbie nominated Craig Nelson with a second from Robyn Kasler. With no other nominations, Cal Tanner moved to close nominations with a second from John Favreau. All in favor. Nelson was elected as moderator.

1. A. Peter Sandberg nominated Greg Lethbridge with a second from Howard Pulchin for a seat on Planning and Zoning, with a term of 2025 -2029. With no other nominations, Frisbie called to close nominations with a second from C. Tanner. All in favor. Lethbridge was elected to Planning and Zoning.
B. Sandberg nominated Molly Smithsimon with a second from Pulchin for a seat on Planning and Zoning, with a term of 2025 – 2029. With no other nominations, Frisbie called to close nominations with a second from Favreau. All in favor. Smithsimon was elected to Planning and Zoning.
C. Sandberg nominated Aaron Schiller with a second from Eric Schneider to fulfil a Planning and Zoning vacancy ending in 2028. With no other nominations, Frisbie called to close nominations with a second from Favreau. All in favor. Schiller was elected to Planning and Zoning.
2. Pulchin nominated Schneider with a second from Bill Lough for Planning and Zoning alternative, with a term of 2025-2028. With no other nominations, Frisbie called to close nominations with a second from Kasler. All in favor. Schneider was elected as an alternate in Planning and Zoning.
3. Frisbie moved, with a second from Kasler to authorize the Board of Selectmen to move forward with the revitalization of the Town Center which includes the Community Field, Town Garage, New Cemetery, and the Center Green. There was discussion on where the revitalization was going to be, and the costs to the residents, with reassurance that the funds are coming from grants, ARPA funds and

private donations. There was also discussion regarding the maintenance, and that it would tie in with DPW duties. All in favor. The motion carried.

4. Frisbie moved, with a second from Favreau to authorize the Board of Selectmen to move the white W Warren sign from the bottom of the entrance to Town Hall to the top. All in favor. The motion carried.
5. Frisbie moved, with a second from Kasler to authorize the Warren Community Garden to expand another 70x80 area for another 18 plots. There was discussion asking if this affected the lease, with no economic impact. It was noted that in the legal notice, that the Warren Community Garden was referenced as the Wasley Garden Club, and that the correction would be made. Frisbie moved, with a second from Favreau to amend to add correction of name and contingent on amending the lease. All in favor. Motion passed.
6. This item was removed as the Warren Church Community Childcare was dissolved.

With no other business, Favreau moved to adjourn with a second from C. Tanner. All in favor. Meeting was adjourned at 8:06 pm.
