I live at 44 Arrow Point Road and strongly oppose the application for a variance for an oversize and over-long floating dock at 39 Arrow Point.

There are many reasons for opposing the application, which will be stated by others opposing the variance. I would like to highlight just two points:

- 1. The Gallys have moored a motor boat well within 50 feet of the shoreline for the past two summers. So, there clearly is no necessity for a longer dock, and hence no hardship complying with current regulations.
- 2. If the rock ledge they are claiming will interfere with the use of their boat were, say, 120 feet from the shoreline, would they be asking for a 120 foot long dock. This clearly highlights the "slippery slope" nature of granting a variance to the Gallys or any other lake resident based on underwater features.

In conclusion, I urge the ZBA to reject this application.
